DENTAL RADIOGRAPHS: A surprising number of dental problems (abscesses, root resorption, etc) can occur under the gumline and go unidentified even after careful examination. Routine full mouth dental radiographs are recommended before any dental cleaning to uncover these underlying problems that may be causing discomfort at a cost of \$99.00. We can then make the best treatment decisions for each tooth. Additional anesthesia time required to complete the radiographs is included.

ORAVET BARRIER SEALANT: We can apply OraVet Barrier Sealant as the last step in your pet's dental cleaning. OraVet creates an invisible barrier that prevents plaque and tartar forming bacteria from attaching to the teeth for up to 2 weeks. At that time we will have a recheck appointment to set a home dental care and prevention plan that is practical for your pet and your family.

PRE- ANESTHETIC BLOOD SCREENS: Since anesthetics are removed from the body through the kidneys and/or liver, it is important to know that internal organ function and blood values are within normal limits. This is best done before the day of the procedure for the most information at the best value.

<u>INTRAVENOUS CATHETER AND FLUIDS:</u> For increased anesthetic safety, we recommend that an intravenous catheter be placed before surgery for delivery of fluids and/or medication to maintain blood pressure throughout the procedure. A local anesthetic is used to minimize any discomfort that may be associated with catheter placement. Catheter and fluids may not always be required, but are always preferred. In the event that the veterinarian deems it optional based on pre-anesthetic examination, knowledge of medical history, and/or pre-anesthetic bloodwork, would you like us to proceed with the catheter placement and fluid administration?
